Brodie Gregory is completing her doctoral work in Industrial/Organizational Psychology at the University of Akron in Akron, Ohio. Throughout the course of her graduate career, Brodie has done part-time and consulting work with a variety of organizations, including those in the health care, manufacturing, consumer products, and public sectors. Most recently, Brodie has worked with the Global Talent Development group at The Timken Company, a worldwide leader in the steel and bearings business. Her research focuses on executive and employee coaching, leadership development, performance management, and feedback.

Brodie recently completed a 3-year term as President of the Northeast Ohio Alumni Chapter, where she led the chapter to two consecutive victories in the Mink Conference. She is currently a class agent for the class of 2003 and an Alumni Admissions Program (AAP) volunteer for Northeast Ohio. As a student at W&L, Brodie was Recruitment Chair and President of Kappa Delta sorority. She was a member of the field hockey team during its transition from a club to varsity sport. Other extracurricular activities included WITS (Women in Technology and Science), Fancy Dress steering committee, volunteering at the Rockbridge County SPCA, and participating in peer health education with LIFE (Lifestyle Information For Everyone).
