Jenelle Mims Marsh is Associate Dean for Students/Academic Services at the University of Alabama School of Law. She supervises the activities of the law school's records, admissions, and career services offices. She has been an administrator at the University of Alabama for the last 28 years, five of those years as an administrator in an undergraduate division and eight years with the Alabama Bar Institute for Continuing Legal Education. She has worked in student affairs for the last 15 years. Additionally, she taught in and served as Director of the Legal Writing Program for 7 years. She continues to teach Remedies at the law school and also teaches in the MBA Program at Alabama.
